

GLOBAL LITERACY PROJECT

The Global Literacy Project is a way for congregations and women's groups to engage in preparing for the International Convocation of Unitarian Universalist Women, which will take place in Houston, Texas, from February 26th to March 1st, 2009. The six sessions introduce participants to major issues in women's lives and how they are being and can be addressed. The program suggests ways congregations can become involved, as a group, with the Convocation process. The curriculum features profiles of UU women from around the world.

Session 1: The United Nations—Commission on the Status of Women, CEDAW, Earth Charter, Millennium Development Goals, Women's UN Report Network

Session 2: Economic Survival—ending poverty, microcredit, social enterprise

Session 3: Girls and Education

Session 4: Health and Healing—AIDS, abuse, grassroots health care systems

Session 5: UUs around the World—International Council of UUs, UUA International Program, UU Partner Church Council, UU-United Nations Office, UU Service Committee

Session 6: Hands around the World—engaging UU congregations and women's group in the convocation process through the partnership-scholarship program
